

Recreational fire permit property owner permission form

Recreational fire permits are required in the City of St. Louis Park. For properties that are occupied by people other than the property owner, a property owner permission form must be signed by the property owner before a recreational fire permit will be issued to the occupants of the property.

The fee for a recreational fire permit is \$25 and is valid as long as the occupant who obtained the permit resides at the property.

Please note that prior to a permit being issued, an inspection of the fire site or fire receptacle must be completed and approved by the St. Louis Park Fire Department.

Holders of recreational fire permits are expected to follow the rules on the application. The rules are available to view at the fire department or online at www.stlouispark.org/fire-department.

A person without a permit or in violation of any provision of the permit is subject to a civil penalty fine of \$100 and/or guilty of a misdemeanor under the City of St. Louis Park Ordinance Section 14-80. A misdemeanor means a crime for which a sentence of not more than 90 days or a fine of not more than \$1,000, or both, may be imposed.

As the property owner, please understand that if you approve the occupants of your property to obtain a recreational fire permit and they are in violation of that permit, they may receive a civil penalty fine of \$100. However, if those occupants fail to pay the civil penalty fine, it will be assessed to you, the property owner.
