UNDESIRABLE PLANT MATERIAL SELECTIONS OR SITE CONDITIONS SHALL BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO BEGINNING OF WORK. NO PLANT MATERIAL SUBSTITUTIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS APPROVAL IS REQUESTED OF THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT BY THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR PRIOR TO THE SUBMISSION OF BID AND/OR
- CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBLE FOR LAYOUT AND STAKING OF PLANT MATERIAL. MATERIAL SHALL BE LOCATED AND STAKED AS SHOWN ON PLAN(S). ALL STAKING AND BASE GRADING TO BE VERIFIED AND APPROVED BY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT IN FIELD PRIOR TO ANY
- FINAL SURFACE MATERIAL INSTALLATIONS. ADJUSTMENTS IN LOCATION OF PROPOSED PLANT MATERIALS MAY BE NEEDED IN FIELD. LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT MUST BE NOTIFIED PRIOR TO ADJUSTMENT OF PLANTS.
- NO PLANTS WILL BE INSTALLED UNTIL FINAL GRADING AND CONSTRUCTION HAVE BEEN COMPLETED IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA. PLANT MATERIALS TO BE INSTALLED PER PLANTING DETAILS. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE THE PHASES OF CONSTRUCTION AND PLANTING INSTALLATION WITH OTHER CONTRACTORS WORKING
