

NOTES:

- 1. CURB BOX MUST BE MCDONALD 5614 A MINNEAPOLIS PATTERN
- 2. MINIMUM RESIDENTIAL SERVICE SIZE IS 1" INSIDE DIAMETER.
- 3. FOR 1 1/2" AND 2" SERVICES, PIPES SHALL HAVE A 45° DEGREE BEND CONNECTED TO THE CORP STOP TO FACILITATE THE DOWNWARD EXPANSION LOOP.
- 4. 2" SERVICE PIPES SHALL HAVE A 2" CURB BOX.
- 5. THE MAINLINE MUST BE TAPPED ON THE SAME SIDE OF THE PIPE THAT THE SERVICE IS LOCATED. NO REVERSE TAPS ALLOWED.
- 6. WATER SERVICE PIPES MUST BE COPPER OR POTABLE WATER GRADE HIGH DENSITY POLYETHYLENE (HDPE).
- 7. TIE CARDS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT. SEE PLATE NO. W-2 WATER SERVICE TIE CARD.
- 8. 1" CONNECTIONS SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM DISTANCE OF 5' BETWEEN TAPS WHEN THE TAPS ARE MADE ON THE SAME SIDE OF THE WATER MAIN. 1" CONNECTIONS MADE ON OPPOSITE SIDES OF THE WATER MAIN REQUIRE A MINIMUM DISTANCE OF 18".

 CONNECTIONS LARGER THAN 1" REQUIRE A MINIMUM DISTANCE OF 5' BETWEEN TAPS. A MINIMUM DISTANCE OF 5' IS REQUIRED BETWEEN THE TAP AND A HYDRANT TEE OR VALVE. A MINIMUM DISTANCE OF 2' IS REQUIRED BETWEEN A TAP AND THE BELL OR FITTING.
