Enclosed is the 2024 tanning facility license application. Payment is due at the same time the application is submitted. Checks should be payable to the "City of St. Louis Park" or we accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express.

Renewal applications are required to be returned before Jan. 1, 2024, and any application postmarked after Jan. 1, 2024, will be subject to a late fee of either \$50 or 25 percent, whichever is greater.

The Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry requires all licensed businesses to complete and submit the attached "Certificate of Compliance" form providing evidence of compliance with the workers' compensation insurance coverage requirement under Minnesota Statutes Chapter 176. Please read, complete, and sign the enclosed form. This form is required with your application. Certificate of Compliance Minnesota Workers' Compensation Law

This form must be completed by the business license applicant.

Minnesota Statutes § 176.182 requires every state and local licensing agency to withhold the issuance or renewal of a license or permit to operate a business in Minnesota until the applicant presents acceptable evidence of compliance with the workers' compensation insurance coverage requirement of Minn. Stat. chapter 176. If the required information is not provided or is falsely stated, it shall result in a \$2,000 penalty assessed against the applicant by the commissioner of the Department of Labor and Industry.

A valid workers' compensation policy must be kept in effect at all times by employers as required by law.
