RE: Delay on Lamplighter Pond Maintenance project

Dear Community Member:

Due to the unseasonably warm weather, the start of the Lamplighter Pond Maintenance project is being delayed.

Initially, the work was anticipated to start in late January. However, above-freezing temperatures are delaying the start of the project.

The delay is necessary to avoid impacts to the surrounding vegetation and slopes of the pond. In order to complete the project, temperatures need to remain below freezing to allow the ground to refreeze and become suitable for heavy equipment to operate.

Once the project starts, it will take about two weeks to finish, weather permitting.
