NOTICE OF HEARING ON TREE PRESERVATION ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the planning commission of the City of St. Louis Park will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, August 7, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. regarding proposed changes to the tree preservation requirements in the zoning code. The amendments add a definition for heritage (or mature) trees, establish standards for replacing heritage trees and offer credits for preserving heritage trees during construction. The current tree preservation regulations apply only to trees on public land, and trees on private commercial properties and within new residential subdivisions. The regulations do not currently apply to trees on existing privately-owned one-family and two-family lots. The draft ordinance does not propose to expand the scope of the code to include trees on existing one- and two- family lots, but it has been part of policy discussions and scope changes related to tree preservation regulations could occur during the process.
